The meeting was held outside on the yard, where these items were discussed as follows:

6/20/19 Correspondence:

1. The council discussed the paperwork of the accounts for the year end 31-3-20, which had been posted to each councillor previously, and it was agreed and confirmed by the councillors present that the accounting statements and Annual Governance Statement were approved by the council as correct.
2. The Defibrillator training took place in Brechfa Church Hall with 11 residents attending, the training was bilingual and very informative, the next training date has not been confirmed due to the Coronavirus Covid 19, we shall wait to hear from the Parliament and advertise this date in the future.
3. A complaint came to the council about a dog that was wandering around the village of Abergorlech and doing it's business on residents property. The clerk spoke to the owner of the dog and they said that they would try to keep the dog at home.
4. The council also had a complaint that no First Aid Training was available at Abergorlech village, a reply was sent to state that the funding from the Brechfa West Wind Farm was paying for the training as well as the defibrillators and cabinets for Brechfa, Gwernogle and Nanttyffin but the Abergorlech defibrillator was paid for by the Community Council as Abergorlech does not come under the fund area. Everybody is welcome to attend the Gwernogle training in the future.
5. Invoice from With Hindsite for Annual Website Hosting Fee totalling £120.00. this was passed for payment by the council.
6. Copies of these documents were received from The One Voice Wales, The Model Standing Order 2018 Wales and also the Financial Regulations (Wales) The council discussed these documents and agreed to accept both and comply to these Documents, these are the basis to all council work.
